Invitation to Membership

As you all know, membership in our Order is by invitation only. With the Calgary and Halifax Investitures fast approaching, now is the time to extend invitations to those whom you would like to be considered for membership in The Order.

An invitation for membership is not based on an individual's personal or financial success; rather Members of The Order are distinguished by a lifetime of accomplishment and service to others. What prospective Postulants need to know:

- There is an initial Fee of Passage of \$750 which covers the cost of the Investiture Ceremony as well as the new member's personal regalia, scroll and vestments.
- Annual membership dues of \$150 are required to maintain membership and the right to wear the Insignia and use the post-nominals
- There is an expectation that members will support the Order's charitable and good works with their actions, efforts and resources according to their means

Once you have extended an invitation and the prospective member accepts, they become a Postulant. The next step is to send them this link to the Postulant Application and Petition:

Priory News

Atlantic Priory:

Atlantic Priory members were front and centre in their community this past year doing good works and deeds. In fact, several members were honoured by being awarded the QEII Platinum Jubilee Medal. They are Dame MacKinnon and Chevaliers Bathurst, Bergeron, Cameron, Carter, Dobson, Goode, Hosford, Pickford, Stoffer and White. Also, Field Dame Christie and Field Knights Bell and McBride - all for Nova Scotia. For New Brunswick – Chevaliers Eastman and Cane. As well, Dame Armstrong was awarded the Minister of Veterans Affairs Commendation. Photos can be found on the website. Another notable accomplishment was the election of Chevalier Eastman as a first-time Councillor to the newly formed Municipal District of St Stephan, NB.

The Priory hosted another successful fundraising golf tournament, in September 2022, for Paws Fur Thought, a service dog provider for veterans with PTSD. With 112 participants, several volunteers and myriad sponsors and donors the priory raised \$52,480. This almost quadrupled the 2021 donation from the same tournament. Since 2017 (less 2020 due to Covid) the priory has raised just over \$124,000 between dinners and golf tournaments. Given that each dog can cost upwards of \$20K that approximates to five veterans

whose lives have been saved. Photos can be found on the website including the 6 Feb 23 cheque presentation.

The priory will not conduct a fundraising golf tournament in 2023; instead, we are going back to a fall black-tie dinner fundraiser to be held in the Wardroom, CFB Halifax on 18 November. The charity remains Paws Fur Thought.

Finally, Atlantic Priory has been approved to have a spring 2024 Investiture held in Halifax. The dates are 26-27 April 2024. We have chosen the Halifax Hotel www.hotelhalifax.ca A superb hotel in downtown Halifax a couple of blocks from the waterfront near Historic Properties https://www.historicproperties.ca/ Further details will be forthcoming from the Order.
